

**ELM PARISH COUNCIL**  
**VACANCY FOR COUNCILLORS**

As a result of the nominations process for the local elections, there will two vacant seats on Elm Parish Council for the Rings End ward.

It is, therefore, necessary for the Parish Council to fill these vacancies by co-option.

To qualify as a co-optee, a person must be:

- 1) a British or EU national citizen
- 2) at least 18 years of age
- 3) free of either criminal record or bankruptcy
- 4) on the list of electors for the parish, or during the whole of the preceding twelve months have either:
  - a) occupied land as owner or tenant within the parish
  - b) had a principal or only place of work there
  - c) lived within three miles of the parish boundary.

If you are interested in becoming a co-opted member for any of the two vacancies on Elm Parish Council, please make application (either by letter or e-mail) to the Clerk to Elm Parish Council, using the contact details at the foot of this notice.

Interested parties should include within their membership application, information (of no more than 500 words) as to why he or she would be suitable for co-option to membership of Elm Parish Council, as well as how he or she meets the qualification criteria.

The deadline for receipt of applications is 7 June 2019 and the Parish Council will undertake the co-option process of the new members at its meeting on the 18 June 2019.
