NOTES

1. Parking – letter from the farmer confirming parking has now been received. The homeowner next to the overflow parking does not have any knowledge of parking in front of their property.
2. Noise. Letter from Easystore expressing the joy from listening to children enjoying themselves in a structured and safe environment.
3. Noise from cars. The club has advised the concerns of the council. However, the club cannot control what parents do or what vehicles they drive. Saying that the plans for commercial or housing at the old Dairy site will deliver vehicle noise from lorries or cars on a more regular basis than currently seen.
4. Car Park. Once the club has stabilised and attained financial growth the club would be more than happy to contribute to the upkeep of the car park and will organise social events to help raise money for the upkeep of the field on an annual basis. Saying that, the club wishes to make it clear that this is the responsibility of the parish council, but they confirm their desire to be a good ‘tenant’ of the field.
5. Speed of development driven by demand from players coming into the club. Next season potentially two x U11’s, one U12s one U9s currently predicted as best case. This will require two pitches only. However, if the club gets an influx of U10 to U8 sides then a third pitch will be needed. This is unlikely for this season.
6. A minimum of one and eventually both current goal posts will be stored in the football storage area. However, they will be replaced by the 9v9 goals which has already been the goals of choice for the children as it reflects their school activities. The adult goals are rarely, if at all used. Adults can use the 9V9 goals quite happily.
