

National Disorder – Local Situation

We'd like to provide you an update regards the current picture nationally and locally regards the incidents of disorder that have been happening across the country.

The national response has been named Operation Navette and that has been the name adopted at a County level by Cambridgeshire Constabulary.

There have not been any reports of disorder within Cambridgeshire but the police have been, and continue to be, very active alongside partner agencies to provide community reassurance.

Importantly, through all the partnership work and community reassurance activity there is no information currently available that indicates there is a likelihood of disorder in Cambridgeshire.

Police resources are being maintained at a level which will allow Cambridgeshire Constabulary to respond to incidents in Cambridgeshire and if necessary, support other police areas.

Be reassured the situation is being continually monitored and there are regular meetings between police and Council Officers at both district and County level.

An important request, if you or your community members has any relevant information linked to the current disorder or potential disorder flash points please share it with the police through the usual channels.
