The events have been timed to coordinate closely with the Whittlesey Big Bash community event.

Cllr Clark, Fenland's Golden Age team leader, said: "These events are incredibly popular and we're always delighted to see new and familiar faces at them.

"New opportunities, services and support for over 60s are regularly being launched in Fenland and this is a chance to find all the current information under one roof.

"Visitors can stroll the stands at their own pace, chat to those who deliver these services, and enjoy free refreshments and a goodie bag to take home too.

"This time we're also putting on an additional event in the evening, that, whilst smaller in scale, will allow an opportunity for those who can't make daytime events to come along."
